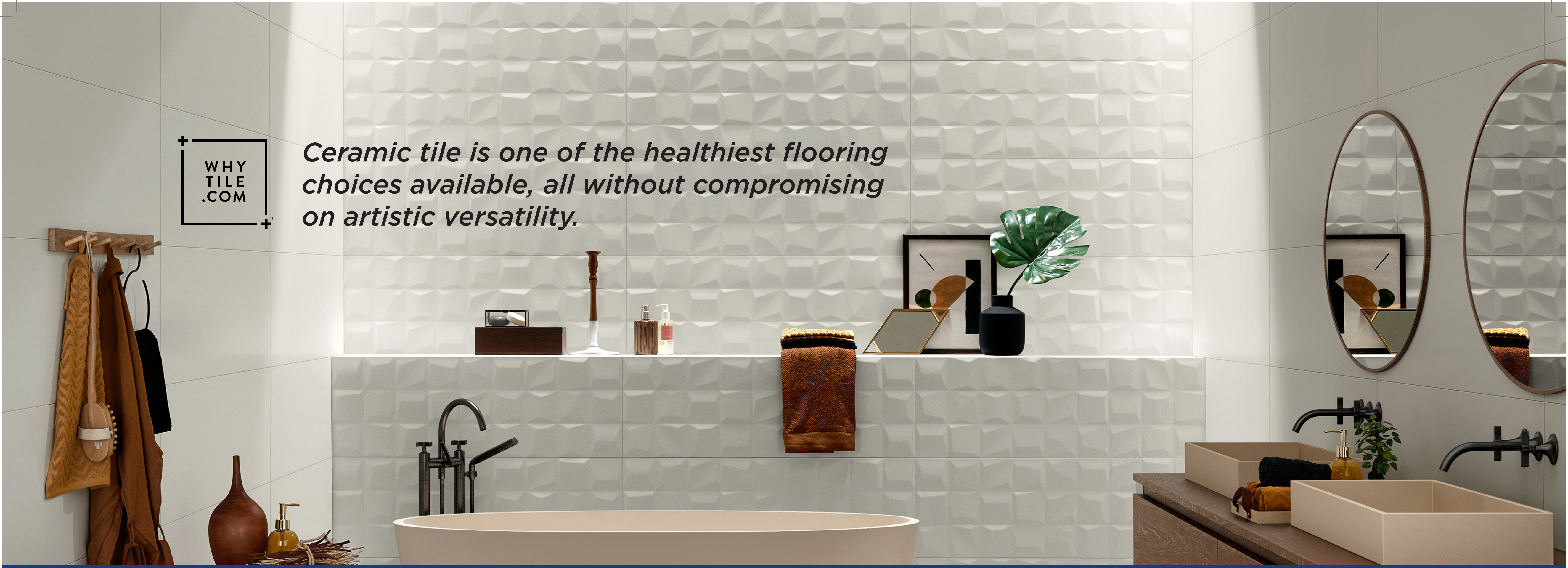

Ceramic's nonporous surface doesn't allow allergens in the environment such as dust, dirt, and pollen to penetrate.



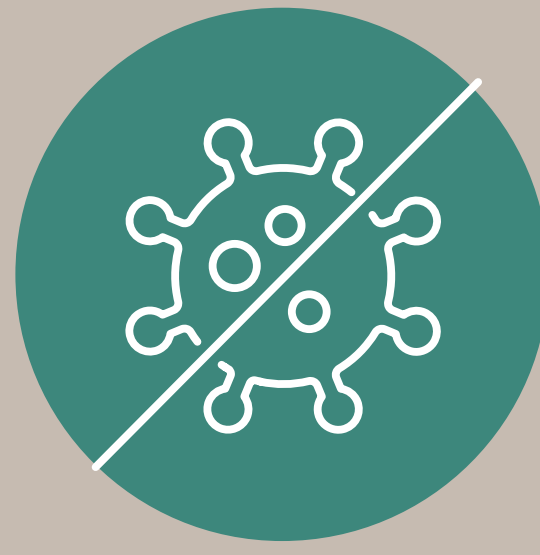
NO PVC

Polyvinyl chloride is a resin found in some vinyl flooring that contains phthalates and organotins, both a concern among health experts.



NO FORMALDEHYDE

Certain levels of formaldehyde can irritate asthma and other respiratory disorders, but ceramic tile does not contain formaldehyde.



ANTIBACTERIAL

Ceramic tile is inhospitable to the growth of bacteria.



NONTOXIC

Ceramic tile doesn't emit any toxic fumes when exposed to fire.



NO VOCs

Volatile organic compounds are harmful gases that cause various health concerns and are emitted by virtually all non-ceramic flooring types.

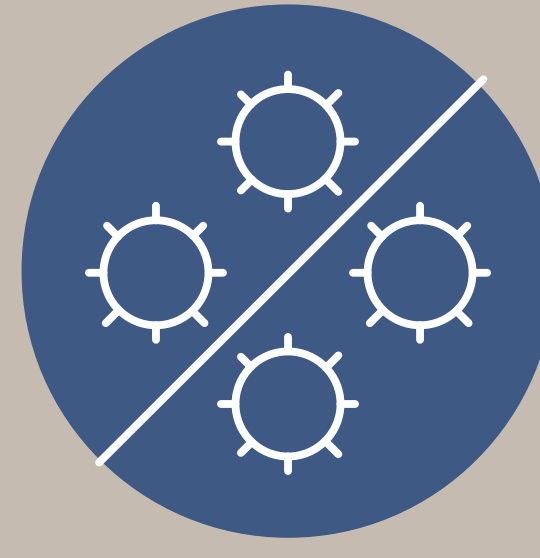
Healthy Cleaning

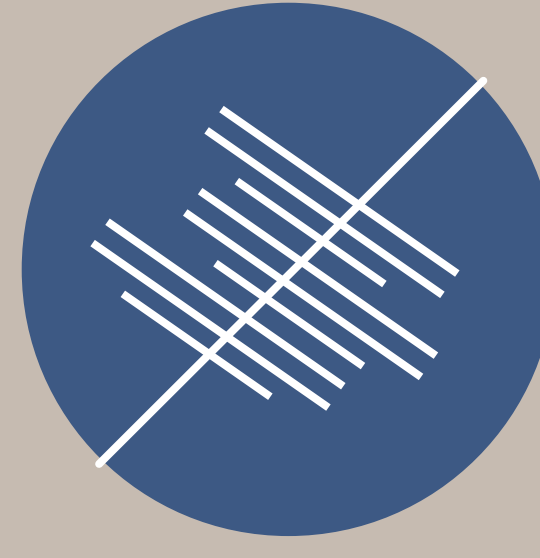
EASY TO CLEAN
